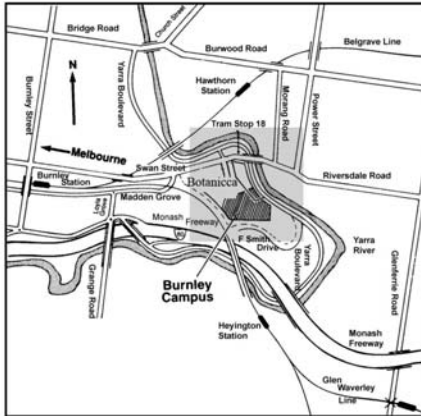

How to get to Burnley



How to get to Burnley

Melway reference: Map 45, Grid A12
Melway map 472 has a detailed Campus map.

By bicycle: Capital City Trail, bike parking and showers are available on campus.

By tram: From Flinders Street along Exhibition St Extension on to Swan Street; Route No. 70, stop 18. From Kew Junction; Route No. 75, stop 29. Along Riversdale Road heading west; Route No 70 stop 18 and Route No. 75, stop 29.

By train: Burnley Station on Lilydale, Belgrave, Alamein or Glen Waverley lines, Hawthorn Station on Lilydale, Belgrave & Alamein lines Heyington Station on Glen Waverley line.

By road: The campus is located at 500 Yarra Boulevard, Richmond. Parking is on the Boulevard. Some parking can also be accessed via the F.R.Smith Drive, follow the signs to 'Burnley Sidings'. There is limited parking on campus for VIP guests. Parking permits are available from reception.

Access from the Eastern Freeway: Take the Chandler Hwy exit and head south. Turn right into Princess Street and follow it through the Kew Junction all the way to the end. (Princess St changes its name to Denmark St. and then again into Power St.) Turn right from the left lane into Swan Street, cross over the bridge and immediately turn left into Burnley's entrance.

Access from Monash Freeway: City bound traffic will need to take the Yarra Boulevard Exit and turn left into the Boulevard. Outbound traffic will need to take the Burnley Street Exit. Burnley tunnel users should stay on Barkly Avenue. Outbound travellers not using the Burnley Tunnel should also take the Burnley Street exit but will need to turn right into Barkly Avenue from the off ramp. Head east along Barkly Avenue, go through the Gibdon Street lights and straight through the Grange Rd roundabout immediately turning right onto the Yarra Boulevard before you enter the freeway onramp. The main entrance will be 2.1km along the boulevard on your left.

You are not allowed to turn right from Swan Street into Burnley's entrance. Cars travelling east along Swan Street will need to turn left at the Botanicca traffic lights and then immediately right onto the Boulevard. Go under the Swan Street bridge and turn right into the Main entrance.
